Christine Zapotoczky Kelleher is chief of investments at the National Gallery of Art. Previously, Christine served as senior investment officer for Georgetown University. She assisted with the founding of Georgetown's Investment Office in 2004 and served as acting chief investment officer in 2011. After Georgetown, Christine led investment strategy, sourcing, and evaluation for Avec Capital. Earlier in her career, she served on the executive team of the Central European University, founded by George Soros, in Budapest, Hungary.
