James Murchie is the President, Co-Founder and CEO of Energy Income Partners (EIP) and Co-Portfolio Manager of EIP's Funds. Founded in 2003, EIP invests in publicly traded energy infrastructure companies that generate stable cash flows by transporting electricity, natural gas and petroleum; "poles & wires, pipes & tanks." The portfolios are concentrated in regulated monopoly companies across a variety of asset classes such as utilities, publicly traded partnerships, and Yield Corporations (YieldCos). EIP's fund family includes a sustainable carbon impact fund invested in companies driving decarbonization in the energy sector.

From 1998 to 2003, Jim managed a long/short equity fund that invested in energy and cyclical equities and commodities as head of Lawhill Capital. From 1995 to 1997, he was a managing director at Tiger Management where his primary responsibility was investments in energy, commodities, and related equities. From 1990-1995 Jim was a principal at Sanford C. Bernstein where he was a top-ranked energy analyst and sat on the Research Department's Recommendation Review Committee. Before joining Bernstein, Jim spent 8 years at British Petroleum in 7 operating and staff positions of increasing responsibility. Jim holds degrees from Rice University and Harvard University.
